RE: Subdistrict No. 3 Replacement Water Accounting for the Month of October 2025

Dear Mr. Cotten,

The following Tables 1, 2, and 3 illustrates Subdistrict No. 3's accounting of its daily replacement operations for the month of October 2025 as required in Term and Condition No. 7 of the State Engineer's 2025 Annual Replacement Plan Approval Letter received on May 1, 2025. The table includes data regarding the following: daily and monthly Subdistrict No. 3 projected stream depletion obligations; replacement/remedy sources used; daily and monthly amount of each replacement/remedy source used; and, identification of the water rights that received replacement/remedy from the Subdistrict on a daily basis.

Synopsis of October 2025 Subdistrict No. 3 Replacement Operations

Under the direction of the Division No. 3 Division Engineer and District 20, 21, and 22 Water Commissioners, Subdistrict No. 3 replaced all projected injurious stream reach depletions on the Rio Grande, Alamosa River, and Conejos River on a daily basis for the month of October 2025 pursuant to the projected amounts calculated in Table 2.3 included in the approved 2025 Annual Replacement Plan. Replacement of injurious stream depletions began on May 1, 2025 on the Rio Grande, the Alamosa River, and the Conejos River.

Replacement Operations on the Rio Grande

For the month of October 2025, Subdistrict No. 3 used 11.77 acre-feet of stored Taos Valley No. 3 water leased from the SLVIWO under SWSP ID# 6074 to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Rio Grande which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict. The following Table 1 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Rio Grande during the month of October 2025.

Per SWSP ID 6074, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of October 2025 in which the Taos Valley No. 3 water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 3 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Rio Grande during the month of October 2025 was 11.77 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 6061, Table 1 illustrates all days during the month of October 2025 in which SLVWCD Transmountain water was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 3 Wells. The total amount of water used to cover daily injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Rio Grande during the month of October 2025 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Replacement Operations on the Conejos

For the month of October 2025, Subdistrict No. 3 used 62.12 acre-feet of stored Alpha Hay Farms water under SWSP ID# 9364, 74.23 acre-feet of BLM's stored Lovato Ditch water under SWSP ID# 6056, and 33.7 acre-feet of Closed Basin Project production to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Conejos River which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict.

The following Table 2 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Conejos during the month of October 2025.

Per SWSP ID 6074 and 6093, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of October 2025 in which the Taos Valley No. 3 water rights was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 3 wells. The total amount used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos River during the month of October 2025 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Under SWSP ID 6056, leased BLM Lovato water was stored in Platoro Reservoir in the amount of 91.64 ac-ft during the months of May and June 2025. The total amount of water used to cover injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos during the month of October 2025 was 86.95 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 6061, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of October 2025 in which SLVWCD Transmountain water was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 3 wells. The total amount of water used to cover daily injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos River during the month of October 2025 was 0.0 ac-ft.

Per SWSP ID 9364, Table 2 illustrates all days during the month of October 2025 in which Alpha Hay Farms water was used to replace depletions caused by Subdistrict No. 3 wells. The total amount of water used to cover daily injurious stream depletions and associated transit losses on the Conejos River was 74.75 ac-ft.

Replacement Operations on the Alamosa

For the month of October 2025, Subdistrict No. 3 used 1.03 acre-feet of stored EXPO LLC excess augmentation water under SWSP ID# 6066 to make replacements to all injured water rights on the Alamosa River which did not have an approved Forbearance Agreement in place with the Subdistrict. The following Table 3 illustrates the Subdistrict's daily replacement operations for the Alamosa during the month of October 2025.

Per SWSP ID 6066, Table 3 illustrates all days during the month of October 2025 in which EXPO LLC water rights were used to replace depletions on the Alamosa River caused by Subdistrict No. 3 Wells. The total amount of water used to remedy injurious stream depletions on the Alamosa River during the month of October 2025 was 1.03 ac-ft.
