Meeting Called to Order

The meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m. A quorum was present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the Agenda-Subdistrict No. 6

Angelo Bellah asked for changes, additions or a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved.

Approval of the Agenda-Subdistrict No. 3

Angelo Bellah asked for changes, additions or a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Doug Bagwell to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Leroy Salazar and unanimously approved.

Public Comment

Angelo Bellah asked for public comment. Jason Coombs reported not fully understanding the Subdistrict No. 6 Pumping Reduction program and the need to make it monetarily viable or people will be reluctant to participate.

Review and Possible Approval of the Los Sauces SWSP Infrastructure Request for Proposal Bids

Angelo Bellah presented the notice request for proposal bids. He reported two (2) bids had been received, one (1) from Robins Construction and the other from Mountain Valley Services. Mr. Bellah highlighted the time sensitivity of the project and the date the project would need to be completed. He presented the bids and reported both companies performed site visits. Mr. Bellah went over the itemized proposal from Robins Construction. Tyler Faucette reported both bids meet the qualifications and asked Mr. Bellah to provide the recommendation from Mony Smith from the Trinchera Subdistrict. Mr. Bellah reported Mr. Smith was in favor of the lower bid from Robins Construction and that he felt both bids were reasonable. Leroy Salazar commented on the exceptional work Robins Construction has completed for him personally. Discussion was held on the reason dual wall pipe would be used, if a trash bracket or screen would be installed and whether or not the bids included two (2) flumes. Clinton Phillips suggested installing a new version of a radar type recorder and explained where it would be placed. David Hofmann reported a second flume would not be required this year but would need to be installed at some point. Discussion was

held on taking the water right through court, the length of the leases with Tommy Martinez and Tresessa an how to protect the investment.

A motion was made by Leroy Salazar to approve the proposal from Adam Robins with clarification two (2) flumes are included, with the assurance that it will be done by the end of the month. The motion was seconded by Ruben Sandoval and unanimously approved.
